## Horace Mann and Illinois Principals Association Announce 2024 Illinois Middle School Principal of the Year

The award recognizes middle school principals who have demonstrated a positive impact on their students and learning community. Criteria for the award include:

Allan Davenport has served as principal at Granger Middle School for the last 5 years and has spent 13 years as a principal. Davenport has also been active in the Illinois Principals Association as a presenter at the Annual Conference and was previously recognized by his peers as DuPage Region Middle School Principal of the Year in 2023.

On effective school leadership, Davenport believes: "You must be present. Beyond being present for the basic duties of the job, principals must be instructionally present in classrooms with teachers, interactively present with kids, and actively present with parents. I believe being a middle school principal is my mission, and I am present each day to ensure that my teachers can teach to the best of their abilities and that my students can learn and reach their full potential. I give my all to this job and will continue to do so for as long as I am blessed to be a principal."
